Hello, I have recently been informed of a planning application for a detached garage opposite my property. 2026/90973 Coppice Drive Netherton.
I would have expected to have been notified of this planning application as it affects my view and access to my driveway.

Whilst I realise the period for objecting to this garage erection has passed, I would like to still convey my concerns.

Currently there had been a shipping container in the garden since COVID. I have repeatedly complained about this and told it was temporary whilst DIY was ongoing at the property.
The planning application in my view should be refused due to the following:

Since the erection of over 200 new houses, Netherton Moor Road and Coppice Drive have become increasingly busy. Cars drive at speed. We have had two crashed at the junction of Netherton moor road and coppice drive, whereby both cars ended up in gardens of Netherton Moor Road properties.
The hedge that surrounds the property in itself causes restricted vision for approaching cars, a permanent structure would impinge the driver's sight. It would also increase danger existing the driveway. The proposed materials for construction are not in keeping with current build. The proposed positioning of said garage is in fact in direct view of our front window.

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
