Heritage statement.

Replacement windows to the above property.

Mrs Carr would like to replace 8No ground floor windows to the front and side of her property.

6No of these windows were replaced previously under guidance from English Heritage and have fallen into a poor state of repair. The proposal is to replace these windows on a like for like basis which will cause no change to the external appearance of the building.

2No larger windows to the front right of the property appear to have been changed at some point in time to slip in Softwood windows which are not very good quality, not in keeping with other windows in the property, and not practical for Mrs Carr to use due to the height of the windows and Mrs Carr's age. The windows are also single glazed and have poor draught proofing which makes them not very thermal efficient. Mrs Carr is proposing to upgrade the thermal properties of these 2No windows by incorporating slimlite double glazing and change layout of the windows to make them easier to operate. The proposed window layout has been based on the existing windows directly above the windows in question, and it is Mrs Carr's and our own opinion that this will be more in keeping with the look of the building than the 2 current windows which stand out as being out of place on the building frontage (see photo below)



The current windows are manufactured in Softwood and it is our proposal to upgrade them to Sapele hardwood to improve the lifespan of the windows.
