<p>This "original" hard standing area has been taken, without permission, from current green belt.</p> <p>The planning application made several years ago for the building to the side of this hardstanding area was for the purpose now being applied for. There are cattle and maintenance machinery/storage/equestrian in that building (not what it had permission for)</p> <p>There will be extra traffic/extended traffic along this lane/drive and through the farmyard, affecting the bridleway/prow.</p> <p>Please see current farm buildings, which have been extended to nearly double their size without planning permission. The new roof sheets can be seen from Back Lane Bristfield to prove.</p> <p>The new building could be used to store 2 Valleys machinery (extra traffic on this narrow lane)</p> <p>Impact on the current site lines from bridleways and lanes and footpaths (running along sowood lane, healey lane, bristfield road, back lane, Bristfield.</p> <p>Impact on houses in the vicinity and their worth being affected.</p> <p>Extra machinery may be brought to store here, the noise and pollution is bad enough as it is.</p> <p>Any extra machinery brought to store here would further damage Healey Lane and the water culverts that run along it.</p>
