<p>The Block Plan shows the latest, proposed building along with the recently approved massive new cattle shed (2025/62/91128/E). This, together with existing building and yard extensions, several of which have taken place without planning approval, gives the impression of an enormous industrial/commercial complex. The whole thing is situated in a prominent, very visible position within the green belt, adversely effecting the character of the area, causing noise and disturbance and damage to the bridleway which provides the only access to the site. Based on the submitted plans, the cattle shed proposal was granted on the basis that access would be up the bridleway from Bristfield village end. Any one visiting the site would see immediately that this is an impossibility.</p> <p>The Design and Access Statement states that the building will make use of an existing area of hard standing and existing concrete panels and so will cause minimal harm to the openness of the Green Belt and that this is a key consideration in areas of Green Belt. Until recently the area in question was not hard standing, but field. The huge concrete panels are the most recent addition. The Photographic Survey included within the Statement (sec 5). shows this clearly. They have been erected without planning, perhaps in anticipation of this application, and already harm the openness of the Green Belt. The electric gates still block the bridleway, but have been moved to further extend the yard and the land around has been concreted creating access to the proposed new build.</p> <p>Not sure if anyone from planning has actually visited the site?
