As a resident of nearby Upper Cumberworth -I wish to object to this application as I have legitimate concerns over the foul drainage from yet another development in this area. The drains run parallel to Park Lane and join the sewer running under Barnsley Road then head towards Denby Dale. This sewer is old and collapses and overflows regularly. There have been many visits from Yorkshire Water resulting in their vehicles getting stuck on Park Lane. I wish to draw attention to Yorkshire Waters comments on Planning Application 2025/60/93572/E under the heading Consultation Responses dated 24/2/26 (id1127847) claiming there is no more capacity in the drains! Neither of these applications appear on the local plan and I do wonder if it would be prudent to halt any more development relying on this drainage network until a solution can be found. This application is one of several in the 5 mile radius and combined together they would break the local infrastructure especially the roads. These applications should be reviewed together and not only in isolation. There are too many accidents on local roads as it is. Lastly I wish to point out an error on this application under the heading Site Analysis 2.7 Local Vernacular where one of the property photographs isn't even in Birdsedge but is a bungalow that was recently for sale in the middle of Upper Cumberworth at the bottom of Carr Hill Road. It does make me question if the developer has done their homework properly!!
