I am writing to formally object to the proposal to build 70 houses on the above land. Below are the reasons why.

Birdsedge is a small village within green belt. There are no amenities e.g shops near at hand.

Transport would be an issue as there is only a very infrequent bus service. It would therefore lead to congestion on the surrounding roads and also highway safety.

Infrastructure would be affected e.g school places and also access to school from the main road, and access to GP practices.

The local sewer and drainage system would not be able to handle this large planned development. Yorkshire Water have no plans to upgrade.

Birdsedge is a beautiful small village set in a green belt area. A development of the size proposed would incur loss of habitat and displacement of animals and birds. We are lucky to have hares, rabbits foxes, deer close by and birds such as pheasants, partridges , grouse, curlews, buzzards, sparrow Hawkes and many other species including bats.
