I have lived at The Barnhouse for the last 27 years and I do not have access to transport. The transport system for Birdsedge is very poor. This site is green belt and I do not believe that there are any extenuating circumstances relevant for the area to be changed from green belt. The extra traffic from the site would have a detrimental effect of road safety. I myself with no personal transport, Crossing the road at any time is dangerous as traffic does not adhere to the speed limit. The police camera van does come regularly but this does not affect the speed people are travelling at. The site would be opposite the village school and at school opening and closing times the traffic is already very heavy. While walking along the footpaths I have been severely affected by the draught caused by speeding traffic particularly the extremely large lorries which speed through the village. We do not have any amenities in the village and the nearest shop is the garage which is one mile away on a very dangerous junction. The impact of building houses on this green belt will be to diminish the land available for the production of crops necessary for the food chain, reduce the habitat of our animals and birds, and future generations will be deprived of the panoramic views and the open countryside for ever. We have several buildings and woods which include the Mill which is listed, Birdsedge Farm which has existed since 1600, my house has been here since the early 1800's, the ancient woodlands and nearby an ancient Quaker village. Any housing estate will completely spoil the character of the settlement with no recourse to restore it to its original state. I believe that the already under strained infrastructure will seriously affect everyone. The internet signal is poor, we have frequent electricity failures and drainage of rainwater is an issue at times.
