I wish to object to this application for the following reasons.

It is proposed to be build on GREEN BELT LAND.

The entrance and exit point to the site would cause a dangerous situation on a very busy and fast road, the A629, which passes through the centre of the village. It is situated only a short distance from Birdsedge First School also the pick up and drop off points for older children going to school.

There would be drainage and flood risk due to loss of trees etc.

The infrastructure for example, GP capacity, school places, sewers, buses must be addressed because they are all struggling now without the increase of 70 houses.

The increase in the number of vehicles on the road would bring even more dangers.
