LAND OFF PENISTONE ROAD, BIRDSEDGE

I wish to make a formal objection to the above proposal on the following grounds:

This site has previously been assessed and REJECTED on the grounds that it does not have a present defensible greenbelt boundary and would present a severe risk of encroachment. There are no exceptional circumstances to remove this site from the greenbelt.

Could present harm to certain heritage sites (mill & 1638 farmhouse) and their setting.

Close to the local school access, causing congestion and increasing the amount of traffic on an already heaving public road system.

There would be an ecological effect on trees, drainage and risk from flooding.

Major loss of countryside and landscape character, so important to the health and wellbeing of local people and visitors.

The current infrastructure is hardly coping now as full capacity has already been reached - doctors, schools, dentist, drains, roads, post office services & shops.

The local plan strategy does NOT include the removal of Birdsedg from the Greenbelt .
