I wish to object to planning Application 2026/91494 for the following reasons: This development was not included in the Local Plan. Nothing has changed since the Local plan was completed so there is no reason to allow this Green Belt site to be developed. Birdsedge is a small village with no shop, pub and very limited public transport so all households will need to use cars whenever they leave for work, for shopping or for social purposes. This will add to the volume of cars using the A629, emerging from a junction that is opposite the school and the village hall, adding to an already congested and dangerous main road. Birdsedge is the home to an amazing variety of wildlife as evidenced in the footage shared on community pages of social media. These include barn owls, badgers, roe deer, pheasants, hares, curlews, skylarks, bats, swallows and house martens. Bats and barn owls are protected species and the site in question is one of the sites where they hunt. Too much wildlife is being lost in the destruction of the Green Belt and I ask that Birdsedge is not added to this list. The infrastructure of the area cannot cope with more houses. The GP surgery has too many patients already, the local school, whilst not full, could not cope with more households of the size intended and Please reject this application
