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Dear Sirs

As a former resident of Birdsedge (1990-2012), I was saddened to hear of a planning application for 70 dwellings in the close vicinity of Birdsedge Farm and on precious green belt as well.

I feel that I must strongly object to this application on the following grounds (amongst others):-

Development on green belt land and conservation area (at least it was when my wife and I lived there).
Not only will the green belt be lost forever, but the remaining surrounding green belt also becomes impacted and less green as a result.

Inevitable increase in pollution due to the development during and after construction; litter and pollution of water courses (the source of the River Dearne is in Birdsedge) adversely affecting the natural habitat and wildlife.

Increase in the population of the village by over 50% without a corresponding increase in the infrastructure and facilities.

Increase in pedestrian and vehicular traffic, particularly affecting the school and the safety of its children, but also village residents.

I really hope that this planning application will be rejected, thus preserving the character and country feel of the village.
