I am writing to object to the proposed planning application 2026/60/91494/E in the land of penistone road, Birsedge.

As a parent of a child at Birsedge First School, it is clear that the development would cause great safety issues to the children. The road is already a hazard, highly congested and the home of numerous accidents. Adding further congestion would hugely endanger families when accessing the school. There is no more space for cars to access the school.

The school itself is small and doesn't have the capacity to grow, it's SEND specialist provision means that a large volume of the students that attend need space and specialist teaching, any growth would be extremely detrimental to these pupils, as would a higher volume of cars on the road.

Children's safety should always be the number 1 priority and more than enough to stop this planning application, however the fact that it is proposed on a green belt area, rich with rare and beautiful flora and fauna (and heritage assets such as the mill, 1638 farmhouse) should also be an undeniable reason.

The local infrastructure cannot cope with this growth, water, sewers or local gps. I firmly object to this proposal that is completely out of line with the local plan.

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
