PLANTING
New soft landscaping to hve a mix of the following:
Crataegus monogyna (Hawthorn)
Carpinus betulus (Hornbeam)
Ilex aquifolium (English holly)
Alnus glutinosa (Alder)
Rosa canina (Dog rose)
Corylus avellana (Hazel).
Whips to be planted in a staggered double row with
5 No plants per meter and should include 3 No plants of
the same species per meter with one of each of the other
two.
The species have been chosen to suit the varied climate
and soil conditions to ensure they are durable.
The hedging will provide a haven for wildlife offering food,
shelter and safe passage for birds and insects.

SOIL PREPARATION
Any weeds or overgrowth to be removed.
Soil to be cultivated to a minimum depth of 300mm.
After planting a weed suppressant and moisture
retentive to be applied.
