Existing Trees Retained
Trees to be retained and protected in line with BS5837:2012. Please refer to Arboricultural Survey for more details.

Existing Trees Removed

Proposed Medium Native Tree
Trees to be planted as 12-14cm girth, Heavy Standard, 3-4m high, to be staked and secured with suitable rubber ties.

Proposed Small Tree
Selected Standard, 10-12cm girth, 3-3.5m height or Multi-stem in 50L Container, 2-2.5m height

Proposed Native Shrub Mix
Bare root stock, 60-80cm, planted at 2m2, in groups of 3-5 Plants. To be protected with spiral guards where necessary.

Proposed Wildlife Friendly Plants
Proposed shrubs and flowering herbaceous plants to be planted as 3-5L pots at 3-5 per sq.m. with individual specimen shrubs.

Proposed Evergreen Hedgerow
60-90cm high, to be planted in 3L container with 5 per lin. m.

Proposed Wildflower Meadow
To be Emorsgate EM2 Standard General Purpose Meadow Mix, supplied by Emorsgate or similar approved. Including 80% or ornamental grasses and 20% of wildflowers Sowing rate 4/gm2.

Proposed Grass
To be turf.
