Assessment

Condition 14 (Stage 1 Safety Audit)

14. Prior to development commencing, a Stage 1 Safety Audit and Designer's Response for the proposed site access and associated alterations covering all aspects of work including those on Scar Lane, shall be submitted to, and approved in writing by, the Local Planning Authority. Before any of the hereby approved buildings are brought into use, the alterations identified within the approved Stage 1 Safety Audit and Designer's Response shall be implemented and retained thereafter.

Reason: *This is a pre-commencement condition to ensure that suitable access arrangements are implemented for the development, in the interest of the safe and efficient use of the Highway, in accordance with Policy LP21 of the Kirklees Local Plan and Chapter 9 of the National Planning Policy Framework.*

The above condition has been reviewed by KC Highway Safety who have provided the following response in their consultation dated 17/07/2026:

The applicant appears to have got one step ahead of themselves on this one. They are required to submit an audit brief for approval prior to any undertaking in accordance with GG119. Once this has been approved by our audit team, they can then progress to the audit. A designer's response should be provided once the audit has been carried out on the pro forma attached.

The current arrangement has not been done in accordance with GG119 and therefore not acceptable.

Please can you advise the applicant.

Following receipt of the above comments, KC Highways had further discussions with the S38 team, who provided an updated S278 Agreement Works, Designers Response to Stage 1 Road Safety Audit, which was updated on the 08/06/2026. KC Highways have reviewed this document and noted in their comments dated 20/07/2026:

To confirm Section 38 have advised the audit has been done and all ok. It threw me initially because not all of the information was included in the DOC application.

This condition can now be discharged.

Officers concur with the above assessment made by KC Highway Safety and recommend that the details submitted are approved. However, Condition 14 has the below requirement which must be adhered to, to ensure ongoing compliance, a note of which is recommended to be included on the decision notice:

Before any of the hereby approved buildings are brought into use, the alterations identified within the approved Stage 1 Safety Audit and Designer's Response shall be implemented and retained thereafter.
