"It is not anticipated to result in any additional demand for parking" I dispute this statement. Many changes in Slaithwaite have already had a detrimental effect on parking. A crossing was placed outside 1436 Manchester Road, leading to reduced on road parking. A free car park on Hollins Row/Manchester Road used by residents, was decommissioned and houses were built on it. A change of use of the chapel on Hollins Row meant that visitors to the chapel now use the already minimal available parking. Introduction of permit parking, etc elsewhere in the village have led to increased parking elsewhere. There is already not enough parking available for local residents. Reviews for the airbnb at 1434 support this. Although residents of 1432 may have used parking as a single home, it is likely that, as 2 homes designed for professionals, there will be an increased need for parking as potentially they may have 4 or more cars. Of course if people parked more considerately the parking would be more adequate. In summary, my objections relate to the increased need for parking such a renovation is likely to bring. If the application is allowed, they need to provide parking spaces too.
