There is the possibility therefore of the houses having more than one car , which indeed most families do nowadays. When they were originally built this was not the expectation. There is room for one car only outside each property. This raises the issue of parking as School Hill already has quite a problem with this, with current residents often unable to park outside their homes. This is compounded by the increase in size of the local school and the Carlton Club. We feel this should be considered and the possible introduction of permit parking. With regards to the Consultation Response we have read regarding the bats, we can confirm that the bats are very evident around the back of the residences of 23 and 25 School Hill and may possibly be in the lofts.
