I have lived on Nann Hall Glade at the bottom of Cliffe Lane for 18 years. During that time I have seen the traffic coming up and down Cliffe Lane increase in both volume and speed. Several times I have had to report to the council the overgrown pavement (which is only on one side of the road). Currently there is barely enough room for one person to walk safely, especially when two cars pass each other on the opposite side of the road and cars skim the kerb. People have to walk into the road to pass each other. It's not safe for prams or pushchairs. Houses in this site will only make the road more unsafe for drivers, who seldom stick to the speed limit.
