It is evident that the assessment does not fully reflect the realities of the area. For example, the photograph used to demonstrate "available parking" was taken at 8:26 a.m. This does not provide an accurate representation of parking conditions during the busiest periods as it also fails to show the double yellows outside of the building as well as the 'keep clear' road markings. To present a fair and balanced assessment, evidence should have been gathered during the peak nursery drop-off and collection times, when parking demand is at its highest. During these peak periods, families with young children and other members of the local community regularly experience significant difficulties finding suitable parking. As a result, parents attending the neighbouring nursery are often left with no practical alternative but to park on double yellow lines or temporarily stop with hazard lights activated. This illustrates the existing pressures on parking capacity and raises concerns about both safety and accessibility. In addition, the community centre, which accommodates the nursery as well as a range of activities and services that benefit the wider community, would also be adversely affected. These services include initiatives such as Meals on Wheels, which supports elderly and vulnerable residents. Any further reduction in available parking or increased obstruction could hinder access for service providers, staff, volunteers, and visitors, potentially impacting the delivery of these important community services.
