There is already an established nursery within the community centre directly opposite where this new nursery is intended to be. I fully support individuals pursuing their career ambitions, although this is so disheartening to see another nursery opening so near by, especially given the challenges already within the area such as parking. My main concern which I think many will agree with is the impact this will have upon parking, congestion and public safety. There is already many cars parked due to drop offs at nursery, activities within the community centre as well as, when the neighbouring church is in use. Introducing a new nursery directly opposite is likely to increase the volume in traffic significantly. This raises the concerns not only for children and families but also for local residents and other road users. A particular concern of mine is emergency services trying to get through but the road being congested with parked/ waiting vehicles, this could really impact the access for police, ambulance or fire services during an emergency. This should really be a key concern when assessing whether another in such close proximity is appropriate or sustainable. My question is whether this proposal is truly viable without the appropriate measures being put in place to address to many issues
