Although Slaithwaite undoubtedly needs another nursery, the location for the proposed one on Nabbs Lane is not appropriate. There will be issues with traffic, congestion, parking and further pollution for the residents in the vicinity. Not to mention the increased chance of accidents. There is currently a nursery and after school club in the community centre over the road at the side of the church. Currently parents will park on the road facing the opposite direction of the traffic. Back doors are left open whilst children are placed in car seats. This can stop and back traffic up until it is safe to pass. We recently had double yellow lines painted on the road coming onto Nabbs Lane due to parking and backed up traffic. Should another nursery be permitted, I can only imagine that as the parents, "will only be 5-10 minutes," parking on the double yellows will become an acceptable norm and trying to get down Nabbs Lane and through the junction and village will once again become a problem.
