I wish to formally object to the proposed change of use to a nursery as this will only exacerbate existing traffic and parking issues. The premises are on a junction and the recent introduction of double yellow lines at the entrance of Nabbs Lane is frequently being abused and ignored creating a blind spot for anyone travelling towards the village centre passing the premises. There is insufficient parking for a nursery offering places up to 50 children and it's unlikely that many potential customers will be using public transport or walking to drop off and collect. The existing on road parking outside the building is already utilised most days which will lead to further congestion of Nabbs Lane, Church Street and nearby Howgate Road. Users accessing the nursery will doubly increase the traffic on Nabbs Lane as they will need to reverse their journey to travel onwards as it is unlikely they will continue along Nabbs Lane away from the village to their destination. Using existing junctions and driveways to facilitate this manoeuvre will create hazardous conditions for both road users and pedestrians.
