There is enough heavy traffic, it is a bus route with four buses an hour past the site and heavy vehicles from the local quarry. I believe more construction traffic will be a danger to the school and locals. There is no obvious route into the plot of land for building site traffic Traffic and residents parking on Back Lane will be impacted. An entire orchard of mature trees will be destroyed. The last planning application fell through as the land is over unstable mine workings There has been no recent testing of these mine workings for this application Local houses are very near and noise and mess has an impact The school playground is next to the site- the whole demolition and building process will affect the school children and the child care facility next to it.
