We do not object to the change of use but we do object to the granting of an alcohol licence operative between the hours of 6am and midnight. The shop will be situated in a primarily residential area, in a street which is very quiet after 10pm. The shop is also situated next door to a premises which has already submitted a planning application to operate as a bar until 10pm. Both businesses are in close proximity to the existing Grove pub. We would suggest it would be more reasonable and appropriate to give a licence to sell alcohol between 7am and 10pm. We would we also ask KMC to consider the implications of additional traffic and parking along this section of Station Road, taking these two planning applications together. The section of Station Road between Strike Lane and Huddersfield Road has become increasingly busy over recent years, with many cars speeding and cars parked along both sides of the road, often partly on pavements.
