<p>I strongly object to this application !</p> <p>The traffic around Blackmoorfoot Road is already to capacity with numerous vehicles including heavy goods vehicles from the quarry which has been in the same place for decades !!</p> <p>Kirklees have already passed the application for 250 new house currently been built at the old st Luke's site which will cause the traffic to increase largely let alone another 750 houses with on average 2 cars each.</p> <p>Crosland Hill Road is also a very busy road at peak times due to it being a cut through from Manchester Road, this is a small country road that due to vehicles being parked can only fit one vehicle at a time, to increase the volume of traffic on this road will have detrimental effect to our area due to noise, pollution and the effects on the many walkers we have.</p> <p>Having lived here for the past 5 years, the 750 houses are going to ruin the landscape and takeaway our much loved countryside, standard fireworks is set back and can't be seen from the road this will not be the case for hundreds of new houses.</p> <p>In regards to schools, and doctors where are all these new people and children going to go ? Schools and doctors are all at full capacity of which people struggle to get an appointment, or a school place within the area they actually live.</p> <p>My final point is regarding the water mains/ drainage being if you are to remove all the fields from the top of the hill, we who live further down end up with the excess water and therefore are put at risk of flooding etc The drainage struggles already with this and therefore will only get worse.</p> <p>All in all these houses are going to ruin our countryside and our living environment as well as causing our tranquil area of Crosland hill becoming like living at the side of the motorway.</p>
