<p>The roads around this proposed development do not have the capacity to cope with so many new cars. With Huddersfield (especially this part if it) being semi rural it is highly unlikely households can use public transport solely and it is therefore a hugh amount of new road users in this area. So many neighbouring roads are narrow and overcrowded. The main road into Huddersfield from the site, Blackmoorfoot Road, has a number of new houses at the old St Lukes site being added to it at the moment and far too frequently the traffic on Blackmoorfoot Road is ridiculously bad already.</p> <p>My next point is regarding what us buried on the proposed land.
