<p>I wish to object to this application, firstly if the dams are filled in the vast amount of water that runs down the hill to the dams will come towards my and my neighbours houses and apparently the overflow from the dams which should take the water down to the river is broken and blocked, since we moved into our house in 2005 our lawn is dying and turning to mud and the playing field at the rear of our property has also become increasingly wet and muddy due to this water flowing down the hill. I also fear for our house foundations as all that displaced water could have a massive effect on the water table of our area. In 2016 when the mill was on fire the fire brigade pumped water out of the dams and were surprised at how quickly they filled back up again. Then there is the wildlife we have a pair of nesting geese who come back every year a pair of herons lots of ducks and the water has a lot of different species of fish and has anyone checked for newts? Then there are several different species of bat that roost in the trees and buildings around the dams these need to be investigated by the bat protection society because as far as I am aware all bats and there roosts are protected.</p> <p>My next objection is vehicular access to and from the site, cars are now parked on both sides of Hart Street all day these cars will block the view of anyone using the access. Hart Street is also one of the main accesses to Hillside Primary and this could cause further traffic problems and danger to school children.</p>
