I wish to object strongly to the planning application 2021/62/92603/E because of the increased likelihood of severe flooding.

Water flow rates are nearly always quoted per minute but the developer has chosen per second in their application to make the number sound small to me, you and the council. Two can play at that game, 42.1l/s of drainage outflow = 3.6 million litres per day.

Recent floods of the Chainbar area are:

- 9th February 2020 - Storm Ciara
- 7th November 2019
- 26th December 2015

It's pretty obvious that an extra 3.6 million litres of water is going to make these events more serious and more frequent.
