I understand that the site would be elevated 20 m from the A58 and a further 7m above the Spen Valley Greenway - BEFORE its own height of a ridiculous 30+m in addition. Who in their right mind would even apply to build such a monstrosity, let alone try to convince the council that it WOULD not affect the look and character of the area. The huge block of a building would completely overcome all its neighbourhood. The cladding is nothing seen in the vicinity. Traffic already builds up at all times of the day on the ramp exiting the M62, direction East, add a couple of lorries into it, plus all the ones queuing to get access to the site, and you might as well be converting the whole Chain Bar interchange area, including the section of M62 around it, into a lorry car park.
