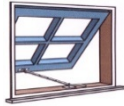


HOW TO MAKE UP A DISINFECTANT SOLUTION

BEFORE YOU START



Always wear protective gloves and an apron.



Wherever it may be possible improve ventilation in area of use.



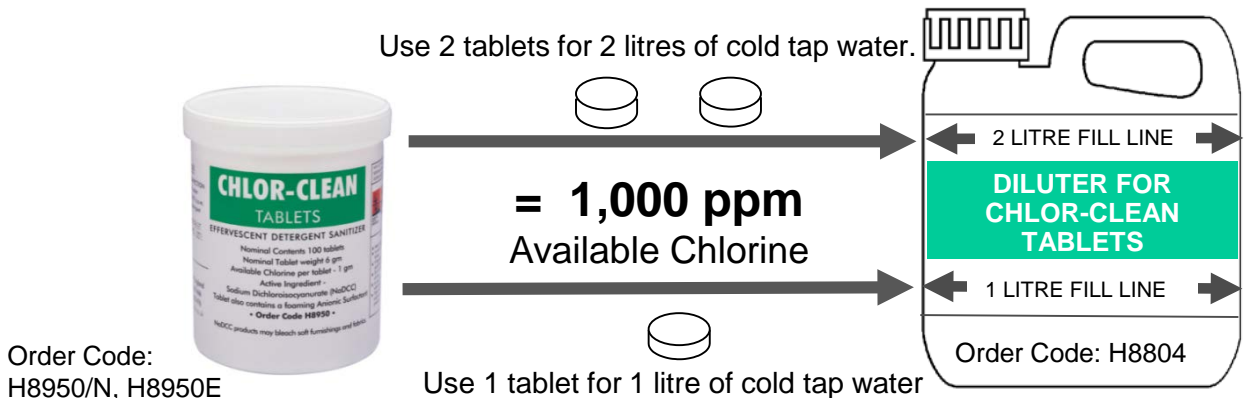
Be aware of the safety notes on the product label and always check the expiry date.

For Terminal Cleans, Isolation Cleans, Outbreak Cleans, etc., and for cleaning and disinfection of surfaces, patient associated equipment (e.g. commodes) and for cleaning & disinfecting after mopping up urine & vomit spills, etc.

NOT SUITABLE FOR USE ON BLOOD SPILLS – SEE BLOOD SPILL POLICY

NOTE: Make sure that the cold tap is **RUNNING COLD** first.

Then fill to the 1 or 2 litre line: Only add one tablet for each litre of **COLD** water.



Use with disposable cloths or mops to clean and disinfect surfaces or floors.

Discard solution after use.

Flush sluice well both *before* and *after* discarding.



Always

- ✓ Make a fresh solution every 24 hours.
- ✓ Always use in a well ventilated area.
- ✓ Store in accordance with safety notes.
- ✓ Change in use solution when it becomes dirty.
- ✓ Only use cold water.

If in doubt about when to use this product contact your Supervisor or your Infection Control Nurse Advisor.

Never

- ▽ Never shake the container to mix.
- ▽ **Never** mix with any other cleaning agent or any other chemical.
- ▽ **Never** use in a spray bottle.
- ▽ Never make up with hot water.
