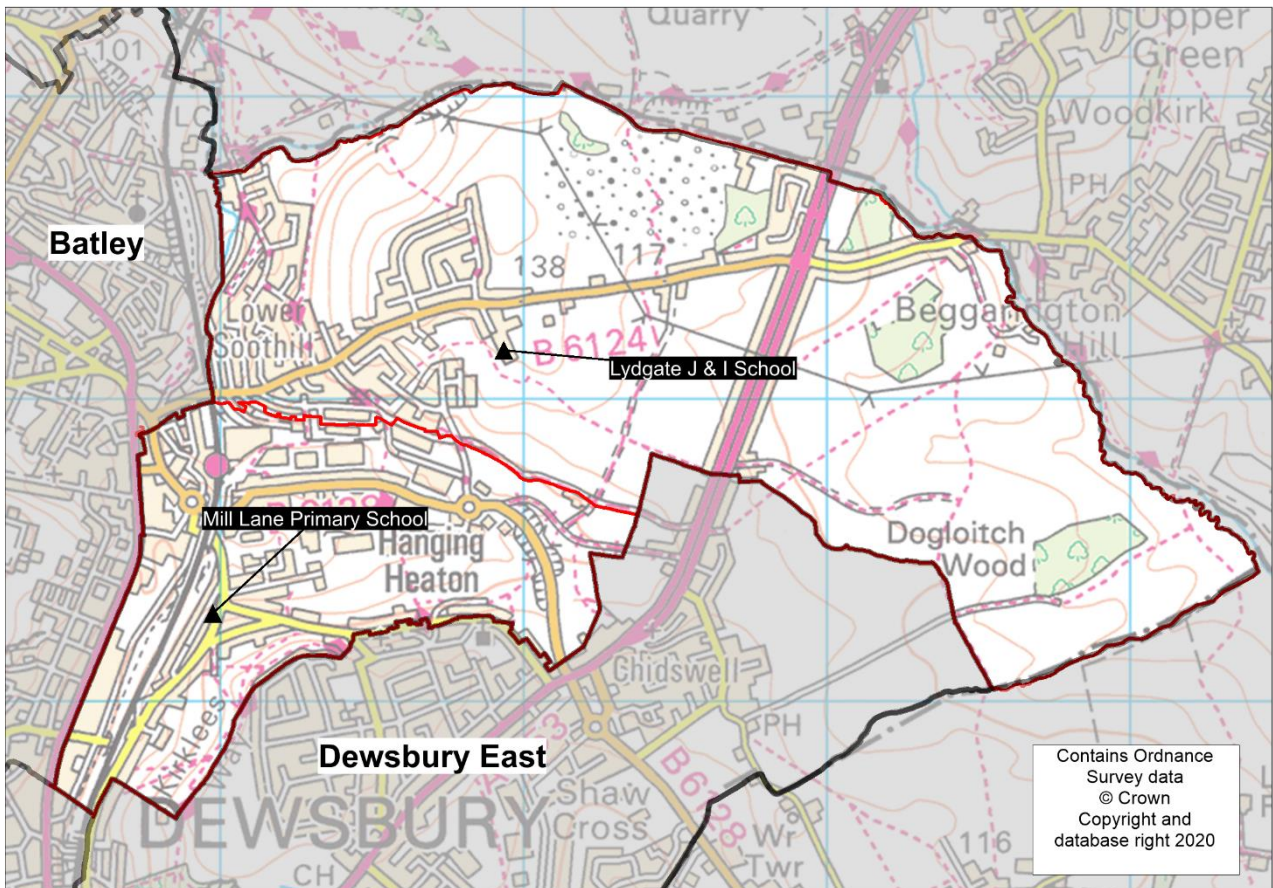


Planning Area 3: Batley East

Overview: The chart on page 65 (and Table B on page 66) shows the demand for Reception places from children resident in this planning area to be broadly static.

In 2019/20 there was a small number of unfilled Reception places.

In 2020/21 there were some unfilled reception places at national offer day. The pattern of pupil distribution illustrates that 54% of the children living in the planning area attend schools in the area, with a number of pupils (30%) attending schools here from neighbouring planning areas, whilst others are securing places in the neighbouring planning area of Batley as well as a small number in schools in other local authorities.

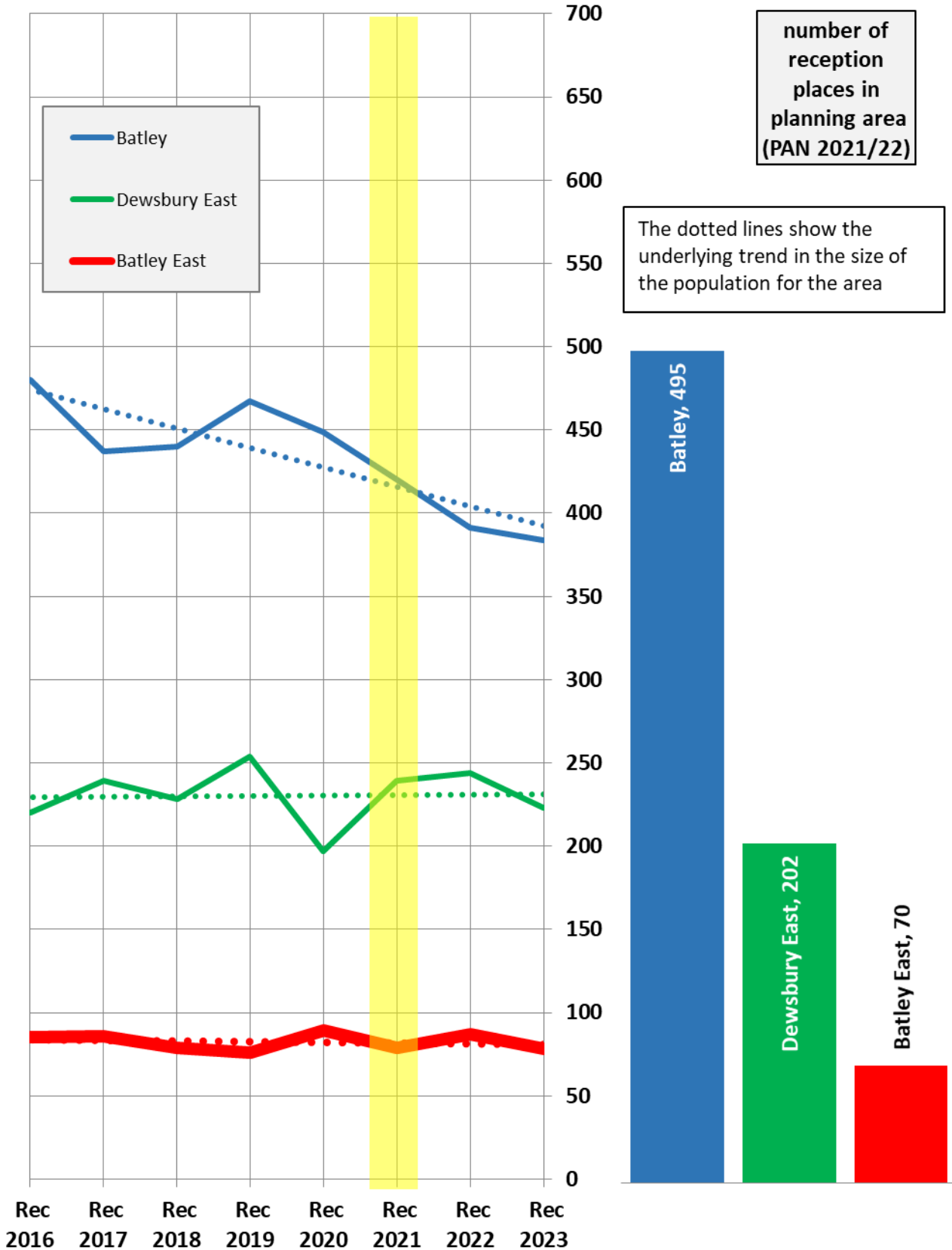
For 2021, 2022 and 2023 it is anticipated that the potential demand for places from those living in the planning area will remain at a similar level to previous years. There is a proposed strategic housing development site in the Local Plan. It is therefore important that the impact of this site on school places remains under constant review.

However, longer term it is likely that there will be a requirement for more primary places through additional infrastructure across a larger strategic area that would include Dewsbury East.
