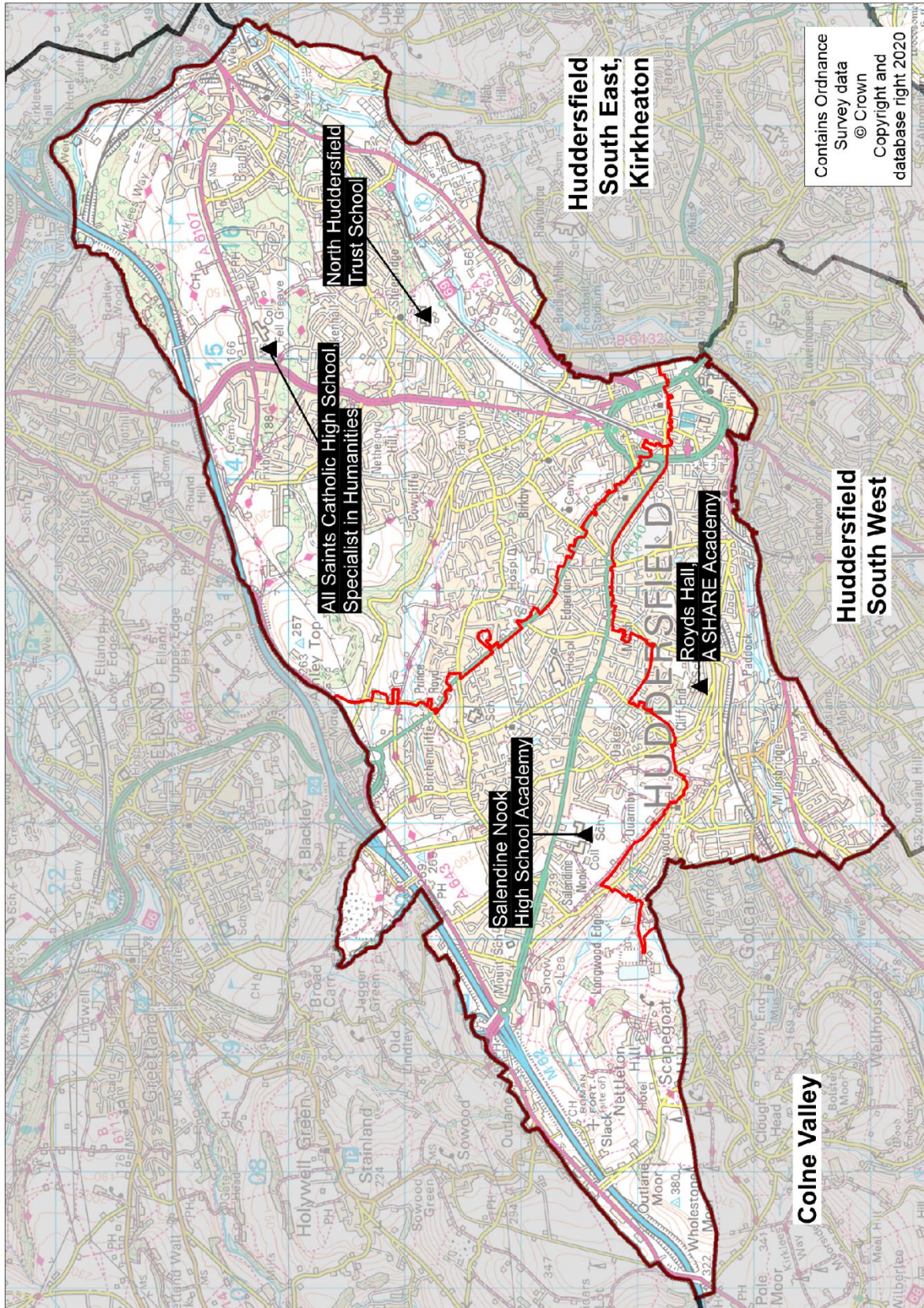


# Planning Area 30: Huddersfield North & West

**Overview:** Table B on page 193 and the chart on page 191 illustrate that the future year 7 cohort size of young people resident in this planning area is broadly static, following a slight rise to 2021

Located in North Huddersfield, All Saints Catholic College has a pupil population residing across South Kirklees and beyond into Calderdale. The LA will continue to liaise closely with the Diocese of Leeds in relation to the demand for Catholic places. North Huddersfield Trust School is also located in North Huddersfield. This school has experienced increasing pupil numbers. Royds Hall, A SHARE Academy is located to the south of the planning area, with Salendine Nook High School located to the north west.

**In 2019/20** there were some unfilled year 7 places in three out of four schools

**In 2020/21** at National Offer Day all Y7 places were allocated. 30 additional places were created as a bulge at North Huddersfield Trust School PAN 180 +30 = 210

The pattern of pupil distribution illustrates that around 64% of children who live in this planning area attend schools in the area, whilst 10% are securing places in neighbouring planning areas. 12% of pupils who are attending schools here are from neighbouring planning areas, with a smaller percentage of around 4% from other LAs.

Historically, in this planning area a significant number of children have secured places in the neighbouring authority of Calderdale. However, there was a marked change between National Offer Day 2019/20 and 2020/21 with 39 fewer Kirklees children securing a place in a Calderdale school.

**For 2021, 2022 and 2023** NHS population data suggests a slight increase in population to 2021, then broadly static to 2023 before some decline after this time. An important factor affecting future demand for places in this planning area will be changing cross-border movement to Calderdale. A modest number of additional places on a permanent and/or bulge basis is likely to be needed in this area.

Engagement with secondary schools has taken place and this will continue to explore a cohesive approach to ensure sufficient secondary school places are available in the wider South Kirklees area.

There are a number of housing development sites with planning permission in the area. Three sites with around 100 dwellings on each are under way and expected to be completed by 2022. Building on one site of 250 dwellings has recently commenced but is likely to take more than five years to complete.


In the **Local Plan** there is a strategic housing development in this planning area which is likely to impact of future demand.

Place planning strategy (assuming current patterns of migration, housing occupancy, parental preference etc)

- Based on NHS population data the projected need for places is **above** the capacity of available places
- On balance, a similar number of children travel **IN** to and **OUT** of the PA to schools in neighbouring PAs.
- A significant number of children travel **OUT** of the PA to schools in Calderdale
- A significant proportion of children travelling **IN** to this area from Calderdale attend All Saints Catholic College
- There is likely to be a need for a modest number of additional places on a permanent and/or bulge basis, in light of the combined impact of a slight increase in population, future housing developments and potential changes to cross-border pupil movement. However, this position will need careful monitoring to establish the emerging impact of these factors.
