

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 06) ORDER 2025
A62 LEEDS ROAD TO HILLHOUSE LANE, HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

- **Introduce a no left turn restriction for vehicles with a weight equal to or greater than 7.5 tonnes from A62 Leeds Road to Hillhouse Lane, Huddersfield**

REASON: It has been brought to the attention of the Council that there is insufficient carriageway width for large vehicles to make the left turn from Leeds Road into Hillhouse Lane, without the vehicles overrunning the footway and/or crossing over the adjacent vehicle running lanes into oncoming vehicles.

This has resulted in several traffic collisions, pedestrian near misses and damage to the traffic signals.

To resolve the issue, it is intended to introduce a No Left Turn ban for goods vehicles 7.5 tonnes and over from Leeds Road to Hillhouse Lane.

It is believed these proposals will improve road safety for all road users.
