

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.23) ORDER 2021
ALMONDBURY BANK, MOLDGREEN AND RILEY STREET, PRIMROSE HILL,
HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, is to

(i) prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Almondbury Bank, Moldgreen, Huddersfield
 - a) North-west side from its junction with Tolson's Yard for a distance of 20 metres in a north-easterly direction
 - b) South-east side from the boundary of Nos. 8/10 to its western vehicular terminal point

(ii) to introduce a permit holder parking place on the following lengths of road: -

1. Riley Street, Primrose Hill, Huddersfield
 - a) On its North-east side from its junction with Newsome Road for a distance of 38 metres in a north-westerly direction
 - b) On its South-west side from a point 36 metres north-west of its junction with Newsome Road for a distance of 10 metres in a north-westerly direction
 - c) On its South-west side from a point 4 metres north-west of its junction with Newsome Road for a distance of 14 metres in a north-westerly direction

These parking places will operate at all times on all days for the use of residents of Nos. 2-36 (evens) and 1-21 (odds) Riley Street

(iii) to revoke items in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (HUDDERSFIELD AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.

The Order was made on 03 May 2022 and comes into effect on 09 May 2022.
