

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 29) ORDER 2022  
TUBBY LANE, FARTOWN, HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

**Prohibit driving on the following length of road for all vehicles at all times:**

Tubby Lane, Fartown

From the rear of the footway on Alder Street for a distance of 3 metres in a north westerly direction.

This Order was made on 21 March 2023 and will take effect on 03 April 2023.
