## KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No. 13) ORDER 2023

## BOND STREET, DEWSBURY

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees have made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in Dewsbury in the Kirklees district, will be as follows:-

1. To prohibit the waiting and loading and unloading of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road:-

## Bond Street, Dewsbury

- a) North Side from a point 9 metres from its junction with Dewsbury Ring Road to its junction with Union Street
- b) North Side from its junction with Union Street for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction
- c) South Side from its junction with Grove Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres
- d) South Side from its junction with Union Street for a distance of 28 metres in a westerly direction
- e) South Side from its junction with Union Street for a distance of 45 metres in a northeasterly direction
- f) South Side from a point 9 metres from its junction with Dewsbury Ring Road for a distance of 17 metres in an easterly direction
- g) South Side from its junction with Grove Street for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction
- 2. To create a loading bay which will operate at all times (with waiting limited to a period of 30 minutes) on the following lengths of road:-

## Bond Street, Dewsbury

- a) South Side from a point 10 metres west from its junction with Grove Street for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction
- b) South Side from a point 28 metres west from its junction with Union Street for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction
- 3. To revoke certain items in the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Dewsbury Area) (Consolidation) Order 2017 which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced
