KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 17) ORDER 2023 GEORGE STREET, NORTHGATE, ROYLE FOLD AND WESTGATE, HECKMONDWIKE

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Heckmondwike area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

(i) Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Northgate, Heckmondwike

North-east side from its junction with George Street for a distance of 112 metres in a north-westerly direction

(ii) Prohibit the waiting or loading and unloading of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road:-

- 1. George Street, Heckmondwike
- a) North-west side from its junction with Northgate in a north-westerly and north-easterly direction for its entire length
- b) South-east side from its junction with Northgate for a distance of 13 metres in a northeasterly direction
- c) South-east side from the north-western kerbline of the Bus Hub entrance for a distance of 43 metres in a north-westerly and south-westerly direction

2. Market Street, Heckmondwike

North side from its junction with Northgate to its junction with Royle Fold

3. Northgate, Heckmondwike

East side from its junction with Westgate to its junction with George Street

- 4. Royle Fold, Heckmondwike
- a) North-west side from its junction with Westgate for a distance of 60 metres in a northeasterly and northerly direction
- b) South-east side from its junction with Market Street in a north-easterly direction for its entire length

AND

(iii) Revoke items in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (CLECKHEATON AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.

This Order was made on 05 March 2024 and will take effect on 15 March 2024.
