KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 19) ORDER 2023 LONGROYD LANE AND ACCESS ROAD OFF LONGROYD LANE, HUDDERSFIELD

Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order

Kirklees Council has a duty under section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 when making Traffic Orders to consider the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic and other traffic, including pedestrians.

The Council considers this Order necessary to facilitate restrictions being introduced as a result of the Huddersfield Southern Corridor scheme, consisting of junction improvements and a new road layout to facilitate pedestrians and cyclists for the following reasons:

- to prohibit waiting at any time on the public highway at the locations described in Schedule 1 for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, as specified in s1 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- to help prevent obstruction of the public highway and reduce congestion, whilst also improving traffic flows and road safety;
- to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic, including pedestrians; and
- to ensure that the restrictions remain relevant and fit for purpose, it is considered appropriate to revoke redundant restrictions as specified in Schedule 2 in order to facilitate the new measures included in this Order
