KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No. 22) ORDER 2023 TURNSTEADS AVENUE, WEST END & ALBION STREET, CLECKHEATON

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in Cleckheaton in the Kirklees district, will be as follows:-

1. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road:

Turnsteads Avenue Cleckheaton

South-west Side from its junction with West End for a distance of 5 metres north-westwards

2. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8:00am – 9:30am and 2:30pm – 4:00pm, Monday to Friday on the following lengths of road:-

West End, Cleckheaton

North-west Side from a point 0.4 metres north-east of its junction with Park View to its junction with Turnsteads Avenue

3. To limit the waiting of vehicles to 60 minutes with no return within 60 minutes on the following lengths of road (The restriction will apply from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday):-

Albion Street, Cleckheaton

North Side 22.4 metres west of its junction with Bradford Road for a distance of 34 metres westwards

(Please note that this is an administrative correction to ensure that existing restrictions on site are mirrored correctly in the legal order, and no on site changes will be made to the existing signing and lining on Albion Street)

- 4. Prohibit the waiting, loading and unloading of vehicles between 8:00am to 9:30am and 14:30pm to 16:00pm, Monday to Friday on the following lengths of road marked with "School Keep Clear" markings:-
- i. Turnsteads Avenue, Cleckheaton
- a) North-east Side from a point 11 metres south-east of the boundary of Nos. 2/4 Turnsteads Avenue for a distance of 43.56 metres north-westwards
- b) North-east Side from a point 1 metres north-west of the boundary of Nos. 30-32 / 34-36 Turnsteads Avenue for a distance of 25 metres south-eastwards
- c) South-west Side from a point 25 metres north-west of the projected boundary of Nos. 22-24 / 26-28 Turnsteads Avenue for a distance of 25 metres north-westwards
- d) South-west Side from a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with West End for a distance of 43.56 metres north-westwards
- e) South-west Side from the projected boundary of Nos. 22-24 / 26 28 Turnsteads Avenue for a distance of 25 metres north-westwards

ii. West End, Cleckheaton

North-west Side from a point 0.4 metres north-east of its junction with Park View for a distance of 25 metres north-westwards

5. To revoke certain items in the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Cleckheaton Area) (Consolidation) Order 2017 which will be redundant when certain of the restrictions referred to above are introduced

This Order was made on 13 February 2024 and will take effect on 23 February 2024.
