

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 111) ORDER 2022
NETHERTON MOOR ROAD, NETHERTON
(Extended 30MPH SPEED LIMIT)**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects roads in the Netherton area in the Kirklees district, will be to:

- Impose a 30mph speed limit on Netherton Moor Road, Netherton from the junction with Moor Lane for a distance of 563m in a south-easterly direction

This order will revoke and replace the following speed limit provision:

- Netherton Moor Road, Netherton 30 mph speed limit from the junction with Moor Lane for a distance of 380m metres in a south-easterly direction

REASON:

This Traffic Regulation Order is required to support the development of land for housing to either side of Netherton Moor Road, Netherton.

The development of 250 houses with new access roads off Netherton Moor Road requires the 30mph/national speed limit transition at the edge of the village to be moved beyond the new accesses.

As a result, it is proposed is to start the 30-mph speed limit from a point 563 metres from the junction of Moor Lane as an appropriate point to reduce driver speeds as they reach the new development access junction.

It is believed this scheme will tackle the potential for inappropriate speed because of the increased traffic volumes expected by introducing the development.

This Order was made on 27 September 2022 and will take effect on 10 October 2022.

Any person wishing to challenge the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirements of that, or of any instrument made under it, have not been complied with may apply to the High Court within six weeks following 07 October 2022.
