(On Street Parking Places) (No 1) Order 2024

Bond Street, Dewsbury

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 45, 46, 47 and 49 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”), and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Specified Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Kirklees) Order 2006 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the local authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 28th day of April 2025 and may be cited as the Kirklees Council (On Street Parking Places) (No 1) Order 2024.
2. Kirklees Metropolitan Council (On Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004 as amended is hereby further amended so as to delete items 1b, 1c and 1d of the Second Schedule to that Order and replace them with the new item 1b specified in the Schedule to this Order.
