

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 A-F
NEW SERVICE ROAD ON THE NORTH-WEST SIDE OF A649, HALIFAX ROAD,
HARTSHEAD MOOR TOP, CLECKHEATON**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on a new service road on the north-east side of Halifax Road, Hartshead Moor from the junction of Sunnybank Close to the junction of Scholes Lane.

Feature 1 – *A 3.7 metre long, 75mm high round-topped tarmac round-topped road hump, the centre point of which is located 15 metres north-west of the south-eastern boundary of No 1018 Halifax Road, measured along the centreline of the new service road.*

Feature 2 – *A 3.7m long, 75mm high round-topped tarmac round-topped road hump, the centre point of which is located 35 metres south-east of the south-eastern boundary of No 1018 Halifax Road, measured along the centreline of the new service road.*
