

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 A-F
KAYE LANE & ASHES LANE, HUDDERSFIELD**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on Kaye Lane and Ashes Lane in Huddersfield.

Plateaus;

These will be flat in profile with a maximum height of 75mm, maximum 6 metres long top with 1.5 metre ramps at 1:20 gradient and will have 200mm drainage channels on both sides.

Feature 1 – Single plateau on Kaye Lane from a point 35 metres south-westwards from the projected western kerblines of Longcroft in a south-westerly direction.

Feature 2 – Single plateau on Kaye Lane from a point 136 metres south-westwards from the projected western kerblines of Longcroft in a south-westerly direction.

Feature 3 – Single plateau on Kaye Lane from a point 81 metres north-eastwards from the projected eastern kerblines of Broken Cross in a north-easterly direction.

Feature 4 – Single plateau on Kaye Lane from a point 8 metres south-westwards from the projected western kerblines of Broken Cross in south-westerly direction.

Feature 6 -Single plateau on Kaye Lane from a point 15 metres eastwards from the boundary line of number 67/67a Kaye Lane in an easterly direction.

Feature 9 -Single plateau on Kaye Lane from a point 15 metres eastwards from the boundary line of 109a/111 Kaye Lane in an easterly direction.

Feature 10 -Single plateau on Kaye Lane from a point 14 metres eastwards from the projected south- western boundary line of the access leading to number 130 Kaye Lane in an easterly direction.

Feature 11 -Single plateau on Ashes Lane from a point 6 metres north-east from the projected north-eastern junction of Clough Hall Lane in a north-easterly direction.

Speed Cushions;

These will be flat in profile with a maximum height of 75mm, 3.5 metres long and 1.6 metres wide with 600 millimetre ramps at 1:8 gradient.

Feature 5 – Two speed cushions staggered on Kaye Lane at a point 4 metres and 10 metres eastwards from the projected property boundary number of 53/55 Kaye Lane in an easterly direction.

Feature 7 – Three speed cushions on Kaye Lane at a point 11 metres north-eastwards from the projected south-western boundary line of property number 66 in a north-easterly direction.

Feature 8 – Three speed cushions on Kaye Lane at a point 36 metres south-westwards from the projected south-eastern boundary line of property number 68 in a south-westerly direction.
