

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 A-F  
Syke Lane and Town Street, Earlsheaton**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on Syke Lane, Earlsheaton.

**Feature 1** – Three speed cushions on Syke Lane: From a point 2 metres south of its junction with Syke Grove in a southerly direction.

**Feature 2** – Three speed cushions on Syke Lane: From a point 14 metres north of its junction with Syke Avenue metres in a northerly direction.

**Feature 3** – Three speed cushions on Syke Lane: From a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Syke Street in a south-westerly direction.

**Feature 4** – Three speed cushions on Syke Lane: From a point 53 metres north-east of its junction with Providence Street in a north-easterly direction.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on Town Street, Earlsheaton.

**Feature 5** – Three speed cushions on Town Street: From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Commercial Street in a north-easterly direction.

**Feature 6** – Two speed cushions on Town Street: From a point 4 metres north-east from its junction with New Street in a north-easterly direction.

**Feature 7** – Two speed cushions on Town Street: From a point 7 metres south-west from its junction with Chatsworth Terrace in a south- westerly direction.

**Feature 8** – Two speed cushions on Town Street: From a point 21 metres south-east of its junction with Park Road in a south-easterly direction.

These speed cushions will be 75mm high, 3.5m in length and 1.6m in width. There will be a minimum separation of 1m between the cushions and a minimum inset from the kerb line of 0.75m.
