

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 A-F
MOORLANDS AVENUE, DEWSBURY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Kirklees Council propose to introduce humps at the following locations on Moorlands Avenue, Dewsbury

Feature 1 – Plateau - From a point 50 metres south-east of the projected south-easterly junction of Moorlands Avenue West in a south-easterly direction.

Feature 2 – Plateau - From a point 15.5 meters south-east of the projected south-easterly junction of Northfield Place in a south-easterly direction.

Feature 3 - Plateau - From a point 35 meters south-east of its junction with Northfield Road in a south-easterly direction.

These plateaus will be 9 metres long, 75mm high, have a flat top 6 metres in length, have ramps 1.5 metres in length with gradients of 1:20 and will span the carriageway from kerb to kerb.
