

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.34) ORDER 2021  
OXFORD ROAD, DEWSBURY**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Dewsbury area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

- (i) **Prohibit the waiting, loading and unloading of vehicles during the times and days specified on the following lengths of road marked with “School Keep Clear” markings:-**

Oxford Road, Dewsbury

On both sides from the boundary of Nos. 32/34 Oxford Road to the boundary of Nos. 53/55 Oxford Road

Monday to Friday, between 8:00am to 9:30am and 14:30pm to 16:00pm, on entrance markings

- (ii) **Revoke items related to Oxford Road in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (DEWSBURY AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.**

**REASON:** This traffic calming scheme and School Keep Clear markings are proposed following a funding stream becoming available under the title of Public Realm Improvements. Local Ward Councillors were asked to identify schemes they felt would benefit their wards based on their experience and knowledge of their wards and concerns expressed by residents and the local Schools.

A traffic calming scheme and School Keep Clear markings outside St. John were requested as part of these discussions.

This scheme is designed to tackle the issues of indiscriminate parking outside St. John Fisher, improve road safety and access and tackle anti-social behaviour based around motor vehicles.
