

## KIRKLEES COUNCIL

### (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.14) ORDER 2020

#### A640 NEW HEY ROAD, OAKES

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in Oakes area in the Kirklees district, will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road:-

New Hey Road, Oakes on its south-western side from a point 9 metres north-west of its extended north-western kerbline of Gibson Street for a distance of 136 metres north-westwards

Reason: It proposed to remove on street parking in the vicinity of the new junction when a new access off New Hey Road (including provision for right turning vehicles and improvement of the existing footways and pedestrian crossing points) is constructed following the grant of planning permission for a new food store on Oakes Mill site, off New Hey Road, Oakes.

It is considered that this will improve visibility and safety for all users and improve the amenities in the area through which these roads run.
