

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 19) ORDER 2022  
VARIOUS ROADS IN BATLEY**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Batley area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

**(i) Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-**

1. Bar Street, Batley

- a) North side from its junction with Field Lane for a distance of 10 metres eastwards
- b) South side from its junction with Bradford Road for a distance of 16 metres westwards

2. Field Lane, Batley

- a) North-east side from its junction with Wood Street to its junction with Hilberoyd Road
- b) North-east side from its junction with Wood Street for a distance of 10 metres north-westwards
- c) North-east side from its junction with Hilberoyd Road for a distance of 38 metres south-eastwards
- d) North-east side from its junction with Bar Street for a distance of 10 metres north-westwards
- e) South side from its junction with Talbot Street for a distance of 45 metres south-eastwards
- f) South-west side from its junction with George Street for a distance of 10 metres north-westwards
- g) South-west side from its junction with George Street for a distance of 10 metres south-eastwards
- h) South-west side from its junction with Talbot Street for a distance of 10 metres north-westwards
- i) South-west side from its junction with Whitaker Street for a distance of 6.5 metres north-westwards
- j) South-west side from its junction with Bradford Road to its junction with Whitaker Street

3. George Street, Batley

Both sides from its junction with Field Lane for a distance of 10 metres south-westwards

4. Howard Street, Batley

- a) Both sides from its junction with Warwick Road for a distance of 10 metres south-eastwards
- b) North side from its junction of Warwick Road for a distance of 10 metres south-eastwards
- c) South-west side from its junction with Warwick Road for a distance of 15.5 metres north-westwards

5. Talbot Street, Batley

- a) North-west side from its junction with Field Lane for a distance of 12 metres south-westwards
- b) South-east side from its junction with Field Lane to the northern boundary of No. 2 Talbot Street / Field Lane Community Centre

6. Warwick Road, Batley

- a) Both sides from its junction of Howard Street for a distance of 10 metres south-westwards
- b) East side from its junction with Howard Street for a distance of 10 metres north-eastwards

7. Whitaker Street, Batley

- a) North-west side from its junction with Field Lane for a distance of 5 metres south-westwards
- b) South-east side from its junction with Field Lane for a distance of 10 metres south-westwards

8. Wood Street, Batley

Both sides from its junction with Wellington Street to its junction with Field Lane

**AND**

**(ii) Revoke items in the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Batley Area) (Consolidation) Order 2017 and the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (No.18) Order 2019, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.**
