

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 25) ORDER 2022
MANOR PARK ROAD, BRADFORD ROAD, MARSH, CLECKHEATON**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Cleckheaton area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Bradford Road, Rawfolds, Cleckheaton
 - a) On its North-east side from a point 5 metres south-east of its extended north-western kerbline of Pearson Street for a distance of 66 metres south-eastwards
 - b) On its North-east side from its junction with Thornton Street for a distance of 23 metres north-westwards
 - c) On its South-west side from its junction with Pearson Street to its junction with Manor Park Road
 - d) On its South-west side from the projected south-eastern kerbline of Manor Park Road for a distance of 112 metres south-eastwards
2. Manor Park Road, Marsh, Cleckheaton

On both sides from its junction with Bradford Road, Marsh for a distance of 22 metres south-westwards

This Order was made on 11 April 2023 and will take effect on 21 April 2023.
