

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 12) ORDER 2022
KITSON HILL ROAD, LEE GREEN AND OLD BANK ROAD, MIRFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees have made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Mirfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

(i) Prohibit the waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Kitson Hill Road, Mirfield

- a) On its North-east side from a point 15 metres north-westwards from the junction of Old Bank Road for a distance of 18 metres north-westwards
- b) On its South-west side from a point 15 metres north-westwards from its junction with Water Royd Lane for a distance of 22 metres north-westwards

2. Lee Green, Mirfield

- a) On its North-east side from a point 15 metres south-eastwards of the junction of Old Bank Road for a distance of 18 metres south-eastwards
- b) On its South-west side from a point 15 metres south-west of the junction of Water Royd Lane for a distance of 16 metres south-eastwards

3. Old Bank Road, Mirfield

- a) On its North-west side from a point 15 metres north-eastwards of the junction with Kitson Hill Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with James Street
- b) On its South-east side from a point 15 metres north-eastwards of the junction of Lee Green for a distance of 21 metres north-eastwards

(ii) Prohibit the waiting or loading and unloading of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road:-

1. Kitson Hill Road, Mirfield

- a) On its North-east side from its junction with Old Bank Road for a distance of 15 metres north-westwards
- b) On its South-west side from its junction with Water Royd Lane for a distance of 15 metres north-westwards

2. Lee Green, Mirfield

- a) On its North-east side from its junction with Old Bank Road for a distance of 15 metres south-eastwards
- b) On its South-west side from its junction with Water Royd Lane for a distance of 15 metres south-eastwards

3. Old Bank Road, Mirfield

- a) On its North-west side from its junction with Kitson Hill Road for a distance of 15 metres north-eastwards
- b) On its South-east side from its junction with Lee Green for a distance of 15 metres in north-eastwards

AND

- (iii) Revoke items in the KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (CLECKHEATON AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.**

This Order was made on 02 May 2023 and will take effect on 11 May 2023.
